BAPTISM OF THE LORD



As we come through the Christmas Season and transition into the liturgical days of Ordinary Time the Church gives to us this beautiful feast of The Baptism of the Lord that stands in the middle. On the first day of the new year we celebrated with great solemnity Mary, Mother of God, and we heard from St. Paul that with the birth of Jesus we have come into the “fullness of time.” We contemplated that day how all time belongs to Jesus, for he truly is the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. This means for us that this is not just another year, a turn of the calendar, but a year of grace and favor in the Lord, 2026 *Anno Domini*. God will be present to us throughout the coming year at all time and in all places, for he holds everything in being in himself. This is a great mystery for us to ponder with Mary, who treasured all these things in her heart, for in Jesus we are not just waiting for things to happen, for in him all things are fulfilled, they don’t just randomly happen.

As proof of this God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts crying out “Abba Father.” Now we are not merely parrots just echoing a sound, but rather we are sons and daughters of God who listen to the voice of the Good Shepherd, who speaks in us through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit crying out within the inner movements of our heart. The heart is that place, the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches, where we live, “the hidden center beyond the grasp of our reason, and of others, only the Spirit of God can fathom the human heart and know it fully. The heart is the place of decision, deeper than our psychic drives. It is the place of truth, where we choose life and death. It is the place of encounter, because as image of God we live in relation.” (2563) And so, it is the heart that prays, the heart that lives in relation to God. This is the new life inaugurated by the Holy Spirit which He has so generously poured over us through Jesus Christ our Saviour.

And baptism is indeed the first stage of our new life in Christ: immersed in God, we are already immersed in the indestructible life of God, and our life of the resurrection begins. Through baptism we have truly been incorporated into a New Creation, a new life and way of existence. However, it takes faith to experience this. If we do not believe the truth of what has happened in our baptism, the reality remains true, but we do not experience the fruits of that reality. In our prayer this Sunday, let’s meditate on the reality of the gift of the Spirit which renewed each one of us in the sacrament. If necessary, let’s renew the sacrament of Baptism by renewing our baptismal promises. And finally, let’s remember that the New Creation is the world to come, the fullness of life that we will experience after the death of this earthly body. For let us not forget that we are on a journey that leads to eternal life in the kingdom of Heaven, prepared for us from the beginning of time and fulfilled for us in the coming of Christ. In these days of Epiphany, we have seen his star rising and come to rest upon him. Therefor, let us no longer live as if we do not know him, living merely day by day searching for pleasure, for money, for prestige and power, this will only undo what Christ has done for us in baptism. No, we have found in him the light of life, and so we rest in him, abiding in him, praying with him. May the coming year be a year of grace and favor for you, and a year of seeing and hearing the God who comes to you in the fullness of time, with his Spirit poured out in you saying, “You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased.”




