Thank you for considering the *Cathedral of the Holy Family* for your wedding reception. We have gone to great lengths in designing our facility to provide an environment which is fresh and inviting, one which you and your guests will be able to enjoy during every part of your once-in-a-lifetime evening.



Facility Overview

We offer an attractive and well-equipped reception venue, well priced among comparable facilities. Holy Family has quickly gained a reputation as one of the top wedding venues in Saskatoon. The Cathedral is fully accessible, climate controlled and features plenty of convenient, free on-site parking.



The Cathedral's main Bishop LeGatt Hall is a bright, open space with tall ceilings and an abundance of natural light. The Hall area also features its own separate coat-check and washrooms.

Rental of the Hall includes sturdy round tables and sleek, comfortable chairs. The Hall also offers a quality sound system with podium microphone as well as a built-in projector and motorized drop-down screen. A modular stage is available if required. Bishop LeGatt Hall will comfortably seat up to 275 people for dinner.

If room for additional tables is required or extra space for mingling is desired, our adjacent Gathering Space can often be utilized in conjunction with the main Hall to create one large, seamless venue.

A built-in hospitality bar, comfortable furniture and striking fieldstone fireplace can offer your guests a stylish and spacious setting, accommodating up to 450 people in the combined space.

The Gathering Space is only available for Friday or Saturday evening events. It does not rent on its own.

Please be aware that only marriage ceremonies authorized by the Pastor may be held on Cathedral property.



Catering

The Cathedral features a modern, well-equipped commercial kitchen. We do not provide in-house catering services or serving staff. Since we're not restricted to a specific caterer, you're free to use the qualified catering personnel of your choice for your special day.



Bar Service

Bar services will be provided by our Knights of Columbus organization, with the renter providing the liquor and Saskatchewan Special Occasion permit. A modest corkage fee is charged to cover the cost of bartenders, mixes and other supplies.

Decoration and Setup

The Hall will be provided with the tables and chairs in place as per your request. Decorations should be limited to table centrepieces and free-standing structures.

The Hall may be booked for decorating at a reduced rate for the afternoon before the wedding if available.

Booking Priority

Couples getting married at the Cathedral may book the facility up to 2 years in advance of the wedding. The Hall may be booked once confirmation is made that the wedding ceremony has been arranged and payment for both the wedding and Hall deposit have been received.



Couples getting married elsewhere may book the Hall for their reception up to 18 months in advance of the wedding. Please be aware that only marriage ceremonies authorized by the Pastor may be held on Cathedral property. Civil ceremonies are not permitted in the Hall area.

Responsibilities

The renter is responsible for the conduct of their guests and workers, both within the facility and on the grounds. Liability insurance is required. Liquor policies must follow government regulations.

A Security Deposit is required at the time of booking in order to confirm the date for your reception. It will also serve later as a damage deposit.

End of Night

All events must be concluded by 2:00 am, including takedown. You need only remove your decorations and other personal belongings at the end of the night. We will provide a thorough cleaning of the facility following your event.

Rental Standards

The Parish and Church believe in cooperating with the greater community to assist in meeting the social, vocational and recreational needs of the community. In support of this belief, the Church will permit the use of parish facilities by others provided there is no conflict with Catholic values, teachings, aims and objectives. The parish administration reserves the right to deny rental of the facility to any individual, organization or user group that in their view does not conform to this rental policy. It is the responsibility of the lessee to ensure compatibility.
